GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION

Collect and transport specimens according to established procedures and standards.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITES

Carry out home visits to obtain blood specimens and collect nonblood specimens such as urine, sputum, and throat swabs for laboratory testing.

Processing specimens including labeling, centrifuging, aliquoting, freezing, and preparing for transport as required by test order

Ensure safe collection and transportation of specimens.

MINOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Perform all non-patient-facing duties, including inventory, stock supplies, sanitizing, filing, answering phones, and utilizing email as appropriate.

Read, understand, and comply with departmental policies, protocols, and procedures.

Assist with the compilation and submission of statistics and data when required.

Maintain all appropriate phlebotomy logs promptly and based on frequency, such as maintenance logs and temperature logs.

Complete online and in-person training courses timely.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE JOB

1-2 year phlebotomy experience

Applicants are required to be at least 18 years of age

preference given to those with home visit experience
